Membership

Membership dues are paid yearly and are for the calendar year, January to December. Annual membership is \$40 for the whole family. This includes the parking pass for the archery range, quarterly President's newsletter, participation in regional tournaments, a discount for supplies at Predator's Archery, and up-to-date notifications about activities happening at the range and in the region.

As part of your membership we request that you contribute some time for volunteer work on the range and other activities of the club. This includes work parties for set-up and day-of operations of club-sponsored shoots such as the Bug Shoot in addition to regular range maintenance. No member is exempt from participating in the work parties. If you cannot attend the scheduled work parties, contact the Range Captain or club President to make arrangements within your schedule. Members are the owners and operators of the club and it takes a team effort to keep the range in the great condition that visitors have come to expect.

Regular Club Activities

Club Shoot Sunday's are held on the second Sunday of each month starting at approximately 9:00 a.m. and are open to all club members. Club Shoots are informal and usually consist of 14 to 28 targets. If you're new to Mt. Madonna Bowmen and the range, the "Club Shoot Sunday" is an excellent time to get to know the range with other club members. Be sure to visit the Mt. Our signature event is the Bug Shoot and it is held the third Sunday in July. We expect approximately 300+ participants each year. This is a large event and requires a lot of planning, organization, and manpower. As a club member, you are requested to volunteer your time to making this event a success. Planning starts in March and requires various levels of assistance all the way through the end of the day of the shoot. General Club Information

Club Meetings are scheduled on the first Thursday of the month at Predator's Archery (7350 Monterey Rd, Gilroy, CA). All club members are invited to attend.

Mount Madonna Bowmen is run by volunteers agreed upon by club members. Any member interested in participating as a club officer should state their interest at a club meeting.

The Club is affiliated with these organizations: National Field Archery Association (NFAA), California Bow Hunters (CBH), and State Archery Association (SAA). Membership in these organizations not required, but is encouraged in order to support archery and bow hunting at state and national levels. General County Ordinances

- Park Hours:** The park is open year-round from 8 a.m. until sunset. All non-campers must leave the park one half hour after sunset.
- Smoking:** Smoking is prohibited on all county parkland.
(Code of Ordinances, Title B, Chapter 5, Sec. B13-82.c)
- Alcohol:** Permitted in picnic areas. Not permitted in parking lots.
- Dogs/Pets:** Must be controlled on a 6-foot (or less) leash at all times.
- Fires:** Permitted in designated barbecue pits only. No fires on open ground. No wood gathering.
- Plants & Wildlife:** Collection of plant specimens and feeding of birds or animals is not permitted. Local animals are to remain unharmed.
- Weapons:** Weapons including spears, missiles, sling shots, traps or hunting devices, air or gas weapons, throwing knives or axes, paintball guns, or any other weapon or device capable of injuring or killing any person or animal are prohibited.
